



LUCY-FUR HAT

It's devilishly cute!

Size 9 or 10 16-inch circular needle
Double points to match

1 skein furry yarn (not the thin eyelash type)
1 skein worsted weight yarn

1. Cast on 76 or 80 stitches in smooth yarn. Work 1 row k2p2 rib.
2. Using furry yarn, purl all stitches for 2 rows.
3. Using 1 strand of smooth yarn, rib (k2, p2) for 8 rows (or 10 rows for a larger size).
4. Change to furry yarn, and again purl all stitches for 2 rows.
5. Repeat rows 3 and 4 one more time

(For a longer adult-sized hat, you could add 8 – 10 additional rows of k2p2 rib with smooth yarn before continuing with the instructions.)

Now change back to smooth yarn and repeat row 3 for only 2 rows.

Next row: using the double pointed needles, work (knit2tog and purl 2 sts) around.

Next row: work (knit 1 st and purl2tog) around.

Next row: k1, p1 around - and repeat this row 3 times.

Next rows: k2 tog all around until you have just a few sts left. Thread a tapestry needle through the yarn tail, run it through remaining sts, and fasten off!
